The new school year has begun! For the safety of all, here are some community reminders:

- With more foot and bike traffic in the mornings and afternoons, please be extra cautious, adhering to the posted speed limit when driving through the community in the mornings and afternoons.
- Stay alert and never pass a bus when its lights are flashing and the stop sign arm is extended. They will be loading or unloading children who may need to cross in front of the bus.
- Be sure to slow down at crosswalks and watch for children who may dart into the roadways unexpectedly.
- For the safety of all, please arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes early. While
  waiting for the bus, do not stand in the street or too close to the curb, waiting until
  the bus comes to a full stop before approaching it.

RECYCLING SCHEDULE: Weeks of September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup>, & 29<sup>th</sup>

#### Residents moving in or preparing to PCS should be informed about bulk trash disposal:

- Bulk items can be placed next to the waste receptacle on scheduled trash days.
- Items must be under 6 feet and weigh less than 250 lbs; no appliances or mattresses.
- Empty moving boxes must be broken down and placed in the recycling receptacle or neatly stacked beside it.
- Trash receptacles should be at the curb the evening before pickup and returned the same day.

Avoid placing trash around installation dumpers; consider donating gently used items to local thrift stores.

Hunt Resident App and Online Portal: Did you know you can use the Hunt Resident App and Online Portal to submit routine maintenance requests? It's a quick and easy way to manage your home needs! Plus, you can view your open work orders and service history right from the app.

- Routine Requests Only: Please note that the Online Portal/Mobile Application should only be used to place routine work orders. If you have an emergency or urgent work order, please contact the maintenance department any time, day or night, by calling (910) 756-3511 and pressing 1.
- If you have questions about an open work order, please call our office at (910) 756-3511 and press 2 during regular office hours for updates. Please note: If a duplicate work order is placed, and the first one has not been completed, the new request will be cancelled and will merge with the original request.
