New to Camp Lejeune Family Housing? Has your military family just arrived at Camp Lejeune or New River? HMC and the Military Family Advisory Network (MFAN) want to help you settle into your new home. Through the PCS Pantry Restock Box program, MFAN and its partners are providing full-sized household staples and everyday essentials for every member of the family, designed to ease your transition and help you feel at home in your new community. If you have moved to Camp Lejeune or New River in the past 90 days, go to Welcome.mfan.org to register for your free PCS Pantry Restock Box today!

REMINDER—Per community guidelines, Marine Corps Installations East-Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune Order 10570.2B, and for the safety of others, domestic animals are not permitted to be off-leash or at large anywhere on the installation. Animals are only allowed to run off leash in the installation at the Camp Lejeune Family Housing designated dog parks/exercise areas.

Pet owners must pick up and properly dispose of all animal waste in their yards and when walking their pets. We ask everyone to help maintain a safe, clean, and pet-friendly community by ensuring all pets are leashed outside of the home and are cleaned up after. 


Hunt Resident App and Online Portal: Did you know you can use the Hunt Resident App and Online Portal to submit routine maintenance requests? It's a quick and easy way to manage your home needs! Plus, you can view your open work orders and service history right from the app.

- Routine Requests Only: Please note that the Online Portal/Mobile Application should only be used to place routine work orders. If you have an emergency or urgent work order, please contact the maintenance department any time, day or night, by calling (910) 756-3511 and pressing 1.
- If you have questions about an open work order, please call our office at (910) 756-3511 and press 2 during regular office hours for updates. Please note: If a duplicate work order is placed, and the first one has not been completed, the new request will be cancelled and will merge with the original request.
