MAINTENANCE TIPS

Reminder – Don't put the wrong objects in your garbage disposal. Your disposal is designed to grind food scraps. Some of the objects that you should avoid putting down your drain include large animal bones, grease, fat, oil, and objects made of glass, plastic, and metal. It's also best to avoid grinding any food that expands, such as spaghetti and rice, because they can clog your disposal.

If you have an emergency or urgent work order, please contact the maintenance department any time, day or night, by calling **(910) 756-3511 and pressing 1**. If you have questions about an open work order, please call our office at (910) 756-3511 and press 2 during regular office hours for updates. Please note: If a duplicate work order is placed, and the first one has not been completed, the new request will be cancelled and will merge with the original request.
