Month of the Military Child

MAINTENANCE TIPS

As temperatures rise, there are several steps you can take to maximize your HVAC system's performance.

- Frequent filter changes. Higher user load or pet load may increase required frequency (once a month).
- Never run your air conditioning while windows or doors are open.
- Maintain exclusion zones around HVAC equipment. Don't store items around the indoor or outdoor units and keep the grass around the outdoor unit maintained.
- Keep pets away from the outdoor unit. Chewing insulation or wires or urinating on an outdoor unit can cause permanent damage.
- HVAC systems remove humidity from the air and allow for that condensation to exit the system into a drain. Damage to this drain line can cause water to fail to reach its intended destination, leading to leaks onto floors.
- Please report any visible water observed to Maintenance right away by calling (910) 756-3511.

Safety Reminders

- Personally owned trampolines are limited to sixteen (16) feet in width and must have side-netting. Side-netting must be used at all times and maintained to manufacturer standards (free of rips and holes). The safety net must have a lock to guard against unauthorized use.
- A written request to erect a trampoline must be submitted to the Community Management Office, and approval must be granted prior to installation.
- Trampolines must be erected within fenced yards, be compatible in size to the homes' rear yard, and only on a flat surface. At no time should the equipment be placed in the front or side yard of the home. An adult (18 years or older) must be present to supervise trampoline use.
- Tenants are responsible for all lawn care (mowing, edging) under and around the trampoline. Tenants are required to restore landscaping under and around the trampoline to its original condition upon move-out.
- Trampolines must be properly secured to prevent movement, rolling, or blowing away. Trampolines must be anchored to the ground using steel stakes and not attached to fences, decks, sheds, trees, or any other part of the premises' structure. Tenants are encouraged to secure additional liability insurance to cover any injuries that may occur as a result of trampoline usage.

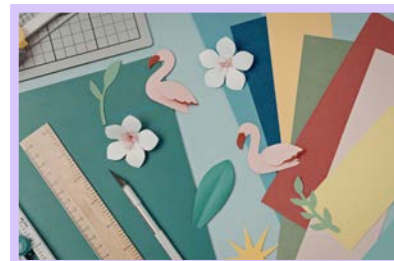
SPRING CRAFTS FOR EVERYONE

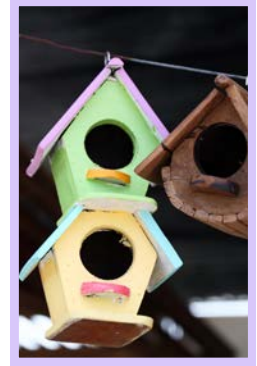

TRASH, RECYCLE, AND BULK SCHEDULE

Trash is collected on a weekly basis at each community under the following schedule. Refuse bins must be at the curb before 7:00 AM on the scheduled pick-up days, unless otherwise instructed by the Community Management Office. If desired, tenant may place the refuse bins at curbside after 6:00 PM the day before collection day. The bins must be returned to proper storage by 8:00 PM on the day of collection. Proper storage is considered along the side of the house, in the garage, in a designated storage area, or as otherwise instructed by the Community Management Office. During weeks with holiday closures, trash is collected per the **Holiday Trash Collection Schedule** provided below.
