MAINTENANCE TIPS

Protecting our community's sewer system is a collective responsibility, and we are asking for your help. Here are a few important ways you can help safeguard our homes, neighborhoods, and the local environment:

- Let cooking grease cool and solidify in an empty jar or can, throw the sealed container in the trash.
- Scrape all food scraps directly into the garbage.
- Dispose of wipes (even those marketed as "flushable"), paper towels, tissues, feminine hygiene products, Q-tips, dental floss, cloth rags in your regular trash bin.
- Only flush water, human waste, and standard toilet paper.

HURRICANE SEASON – June 1st to November 20th

Prepare an emergency supply kit including:

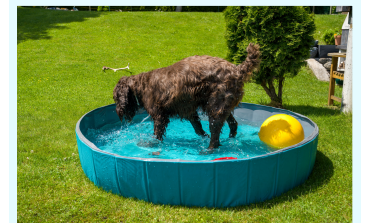
- Copies of prescription medications and medical supplies.
- Bedding and comfortable clothing, including sleeping bags and pillows.
- Bottled water, a battery-operated radio, extra batteries, a first aid kit, and a flashlight.
- Copies of important documents, including driver's license, Social Security card, proof of residence, insurance policies, wills, deeds, birth and marriage certificates, tax records, family photos, etc.

Safety Reminder – Wading Pools/ Splash Pads/Swimming Pools/Hot Tubs

Use of small wading pools, not exceeding 12 inches in height, is authorized only under the following conditions:

- The water must not exceed 12 inches in depth and shall be emptied after use.
- Wading pools are to be constantly monitored by an adult during use and must not be left unattended while holding water.
- Pools are to be emptied, turned over, and properly stored when not in use.
- Grounds damaged by the pools must be restored by the resident.
- Hot tubs, swimming pools, fountains, ponds, or anything that holds water more than 12 inches are prohibited.

TRASH, RECYCLE, AND BULK SCHEDULE

Trash is collected on a weekly basis at each community under the following schedule. Refuse bins must be at the curb before 7:00 AM on the scheduled pick-up days, unless otherwise instructed by the Community Management Office. If desired, tenant may place the refuse bins at curbside after 6:00 PM the day before collection day. The bins must be returned to proper storage by 8:00 PM on the day of collection. Proper storage is considered along the side of the house, in the garage, in a designated storage area, or as otherwise instructed by the Community Management Office. During weeks with holiday closures, trash is collected per the **Holiday Trash Collection Schedule** provided below.
